



**Margaret J. Hoffman Scholarship for
Citizens of Tribes Indigenous to the United States
Administered through the Center Multicultural and Diversity Education**

The Hoffman Scholarship is a one-year, non-renewal \$1,500.00 scholarship for students of a federally- recognized tribes indigenous to the US.

Criteria to receive this scholarship

Recipients of this scholarship must be enrolled at the University of Arkansas and must have acquired and/or maintain a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 or higher throughout the year of funding.

Application materials

All prospective candidates must complete and submit the following information:

1. A completed application (see below)
2. A typed essay (no more than 500 words) articulating future educational and career goals and aspirations.
3. One letter of support from a community leader or faculty member
4. If an incoming student to the U of A, please send copy of your high school or college transcript
5. A copy of a tribal membership card
